Coordinator: Go on your way strengthening your choir and church in their many endeavors.

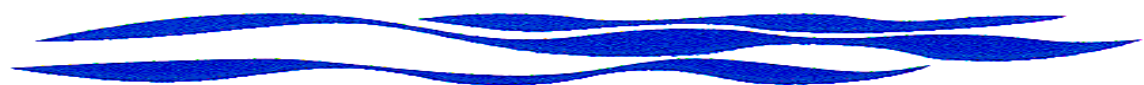
Clinician: Go on your way singing from the depths of your being and with all creation.
